



Chart 1 Export shares. Share of total exports. 1835 and 2013





Chart 2 Terms of trade. Index. 1990=100





Chart 3 Consumer price index. Index. 1998=100





Chart 4 Oil price. USD per barrel at constant 2016 USD





Chart 5 Lending rates and unemployment<sup>1)</sup>. Percent





## Chart 7 Income from the petroleum sector<sup>1)</sup>. In billions of NOK




Chart 8 Rig rates and oil price.

Daily rig rates in thousands of USD. Oil price in USD per barrel





Chart 9 Changes in unemployment. Change from January 2015 to January 2016. Percentage points





Chart 10 Government petroleum revenues and spending of petroleum revenues. In billions of NOK





Chart 11 Transfers to the Government Pension Fund Global (GPFG). In billions of NOK





Chart 12 Government Pension Fund Global (GPFG). In billions of NOK. At 31 December 2015





Chart 13 Asset classes broken down by share of market value. Percent





Chart 14 International interest rates. Long-term interest rates. 14 OECD countries<sup>1)</sup>. Percent




