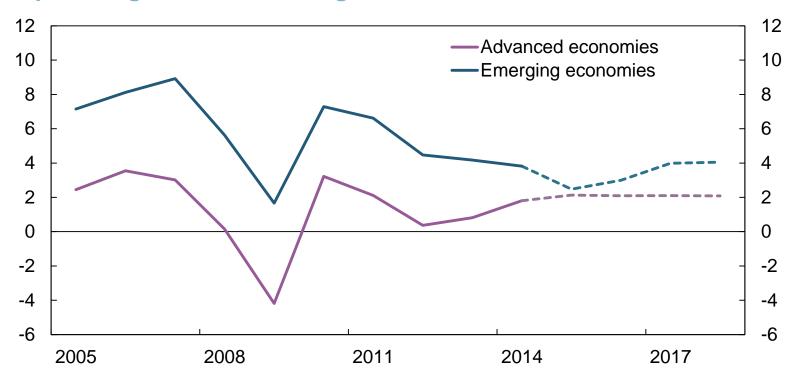

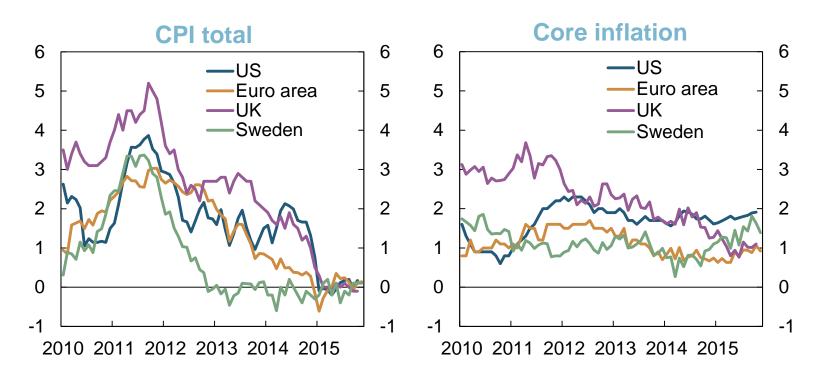
Export weights. Annual change. Percent. 2005 - 2018





Consumer prices, trading partners

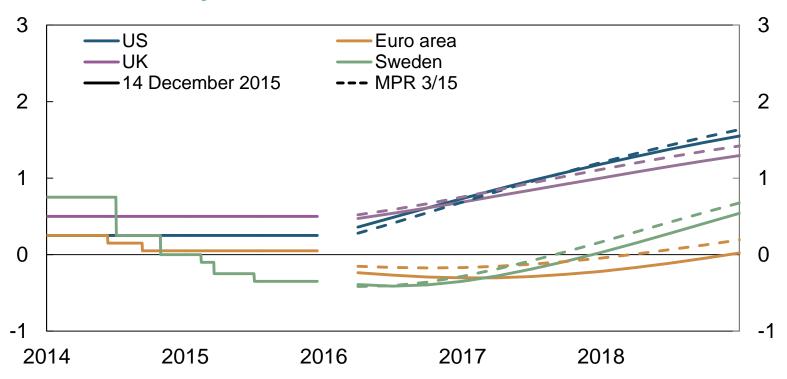
Twelve-month change. Percent. January 2010 – November 2015





Actual and expected key rates

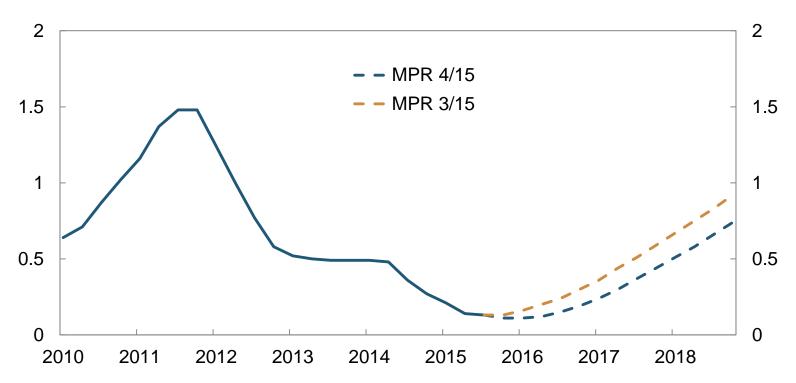

Money market rates for trading partners

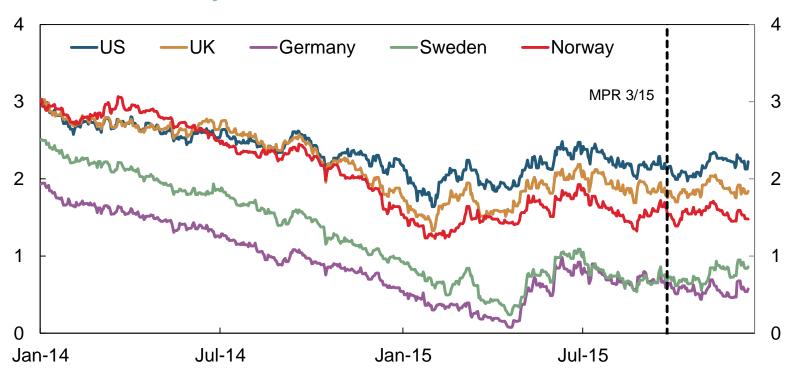

Yields on 10-year government bonds

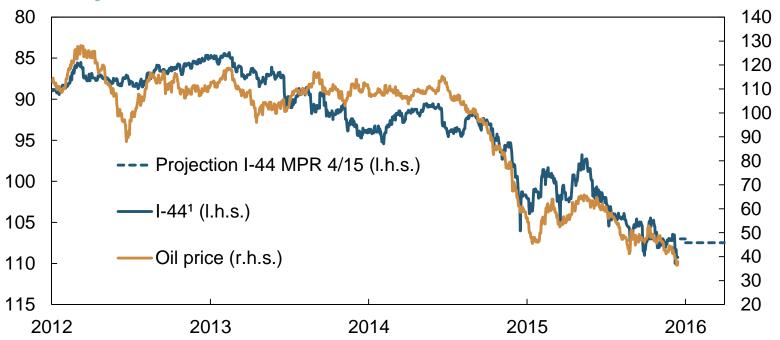

Three-month Nibor spread

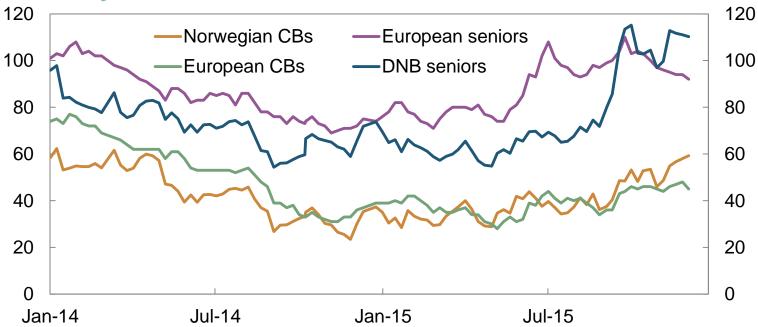
Five-day moving average. Percentage points. January 2010 – June 2016





Risk premiums on bank bonds and covered bonds (CB)

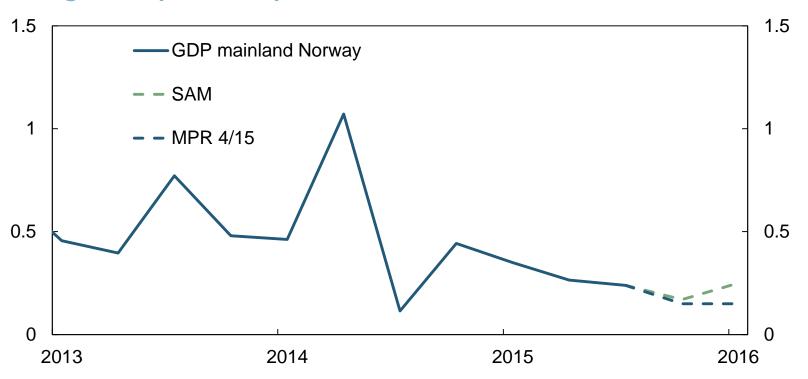
Against German government bond yields. Basis points. 8 January 2014 – 9 December 2015





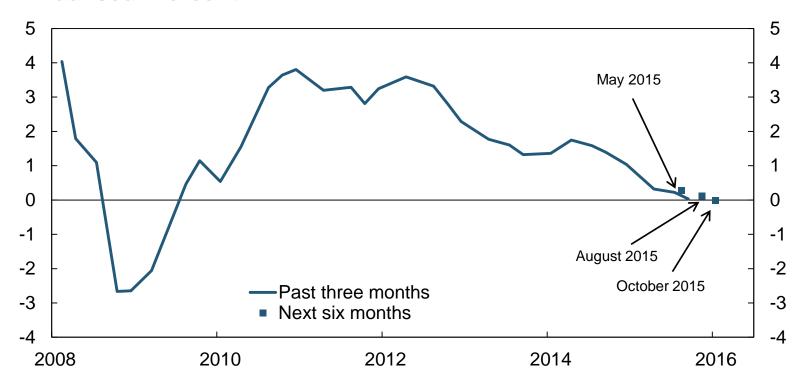
GDP mainland Norway

Annualised. Percent

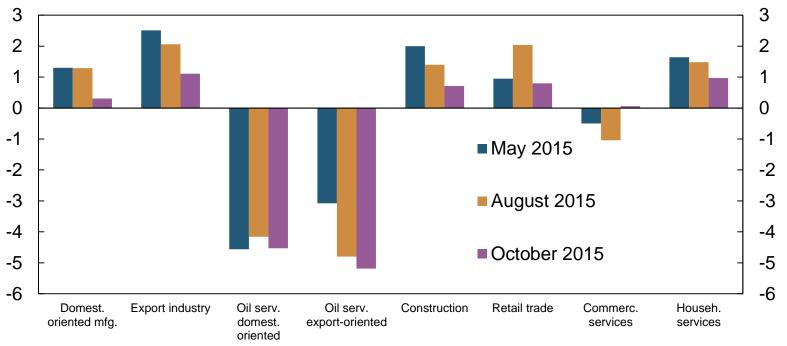

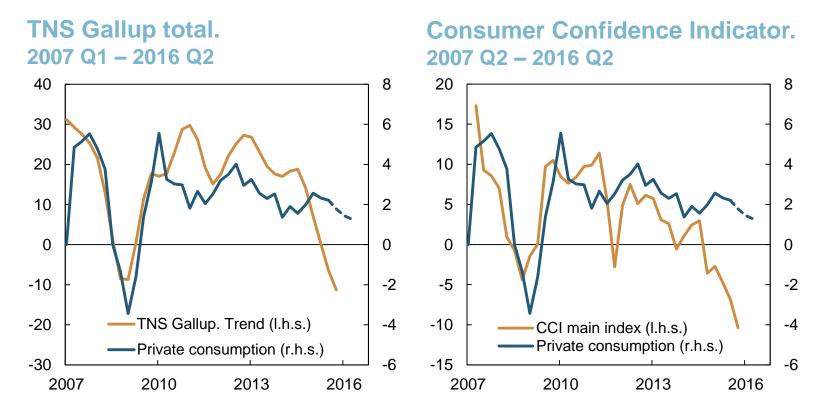
Expected output growth next six months¹⁾. Annualised. Percent

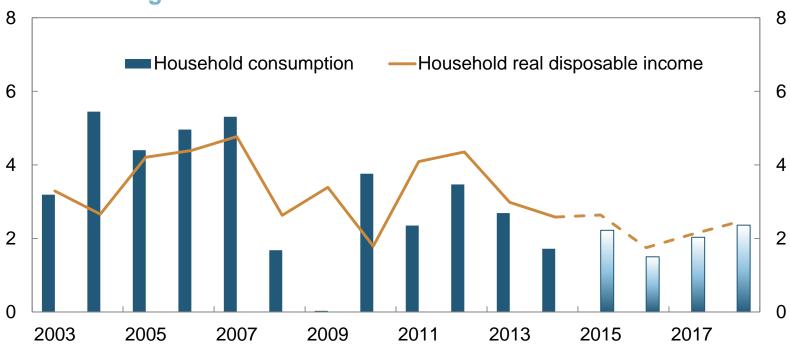
Four-quarter change in private consumption. Percent

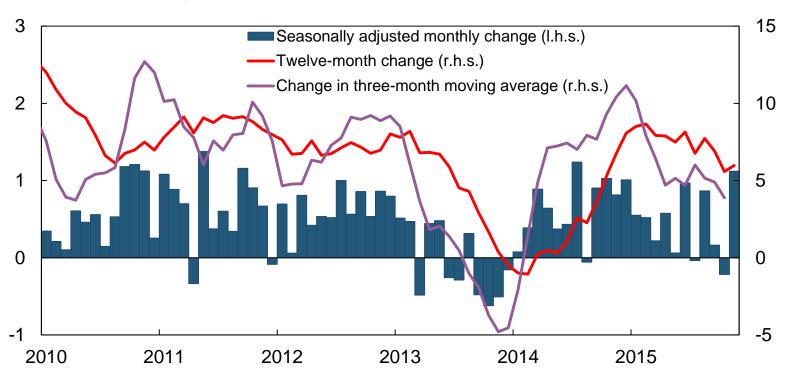

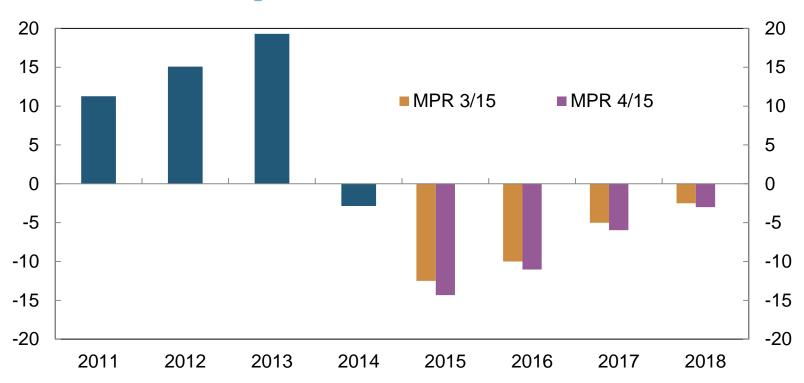

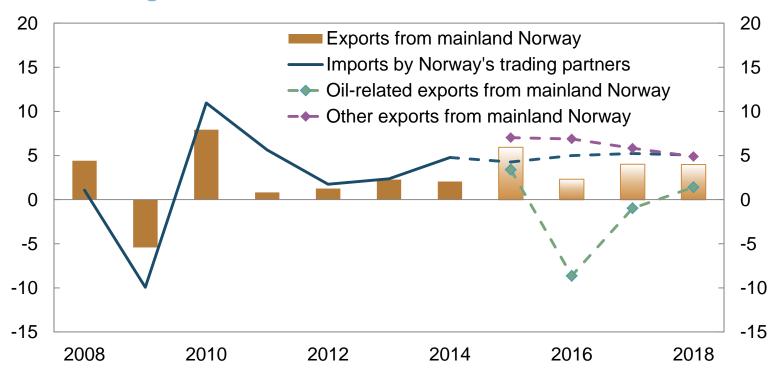

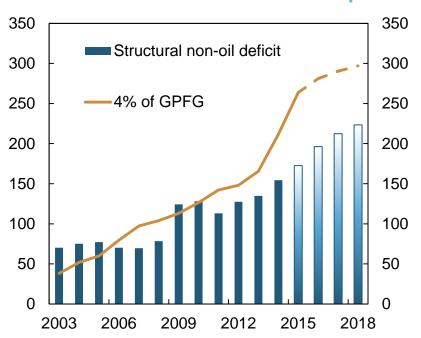

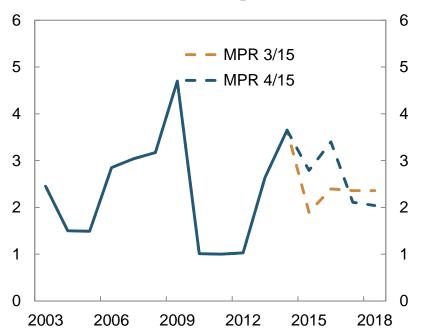

Structural non-oil deficit. In billions of NOK. Constant 2016 prices



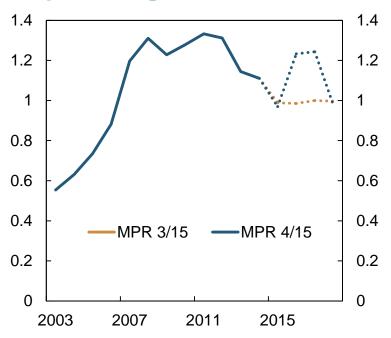
Public sector demand. Volume. Annual change. Percent



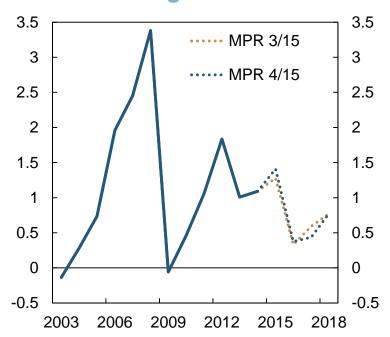


Growth in population and labour force

Population growth. Percent



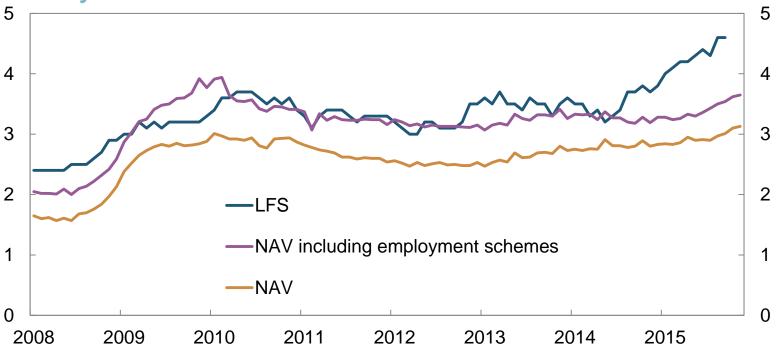
Labour force growth. Percent





Unemployment rate

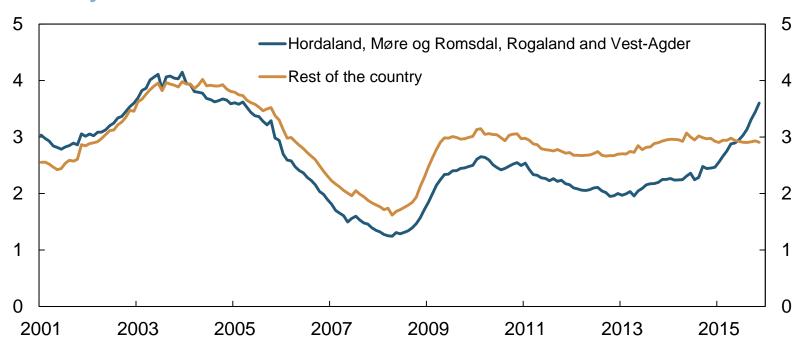
As percentage of labour force. Seasonally adjusted. January 2008 – November 2015





Registered unemployment by county

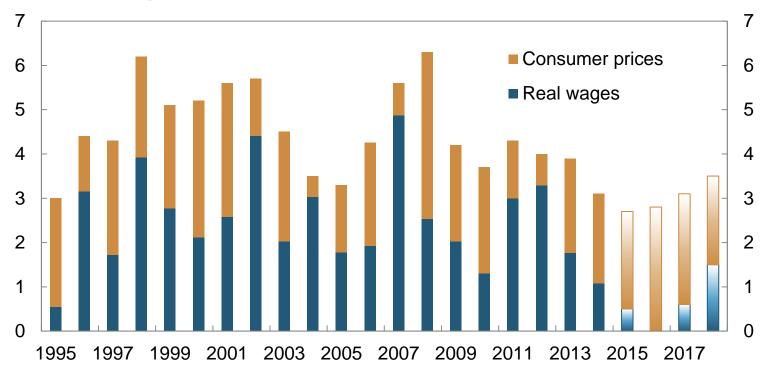

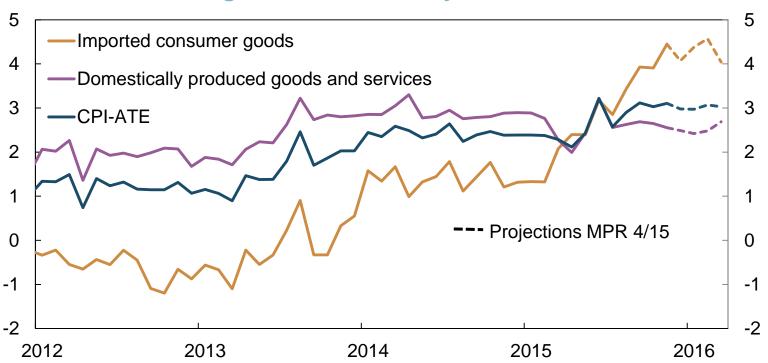
Annual change. Percent. 1995 - 2018



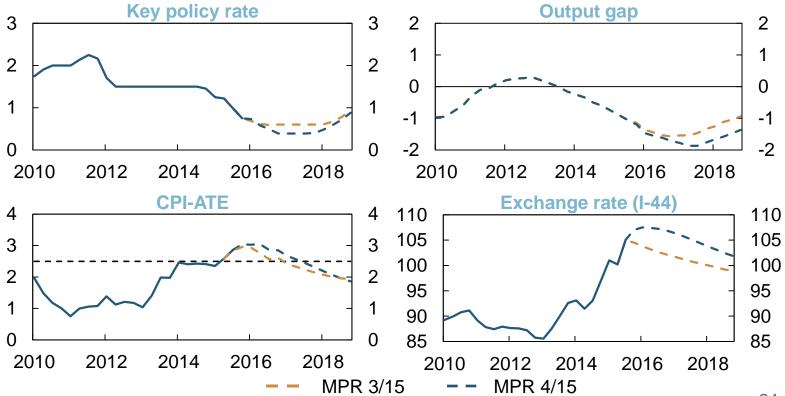


CPI-ATE. Total and by supplier sector
