



Diffusion index. January 2018 – September 2020



GDP forecast for trading partners¹⁾





Change in the number of registered infected per day Change in the number of registered infected per 100 000 population. Seven-day moving average. 1 January – 2 November 2020




Crude oil spot and futures prices




Money market rates for Norway's trading partners

Three-month money market rates for Norway's trading partners. Percent. 2012 Q1 – 2022 Q4




Long-term sovereign yields

Ten-year government bonds. Percent. 1 January 2020 – 3 November 2020




Global equity markets

Three-month money market premium


Percentage points. 1 January 2015 – 31 December 2022¹⁾

Nominal, floating interest rate. July 2018 – November 2020¹⁾



Import-weighted exchange rate index (I-44)


October 2019 – December 2020¹⁾


Monthly growth. Seasonally adjusted. Percent. October 2019 – December 2020¹⁾


Business tendency survey. Composite indicator. Net values. PMI. Diffusion index. Seasonally adjusted. January 2008 – October 2020




Structural non-oil deficit as a share of GPFG. Percent. 2002 – 2023


Goods consumption

Seasonally adjusted volume index. January 2015 – August 2020





Value of card transactions via BankAxept in 2020 relative to 2019.^{1),2)} January – October. Percent




Twelve-month change. Percent. January 2014 – December 2020¹⁾


C2.Twelve-month change. Percent. January 2014 – December 2020¹⁾


Share of labour force. Percent. Seasonally adjusted. January 2014 – December 2020¹⁾

Fully and partly unemployed


Registered unemployed. Percent. January – October 2020


Registered furloughs. In thousands. January – October 2020


Furloughs and ordinary unemployed

Number of unemployed. Week 33 – Week 48




LFS employment and hours worked

In thousands. Population aged 15-74. Seasonally adjusted. January 2014 – September 2020





Twelve-month change. Percent. January 2014 – December 2020¹⁾





CPI-ATE by supplier sector


Twelve-month change. Percent. January 2014 – December 2020¹⁾
