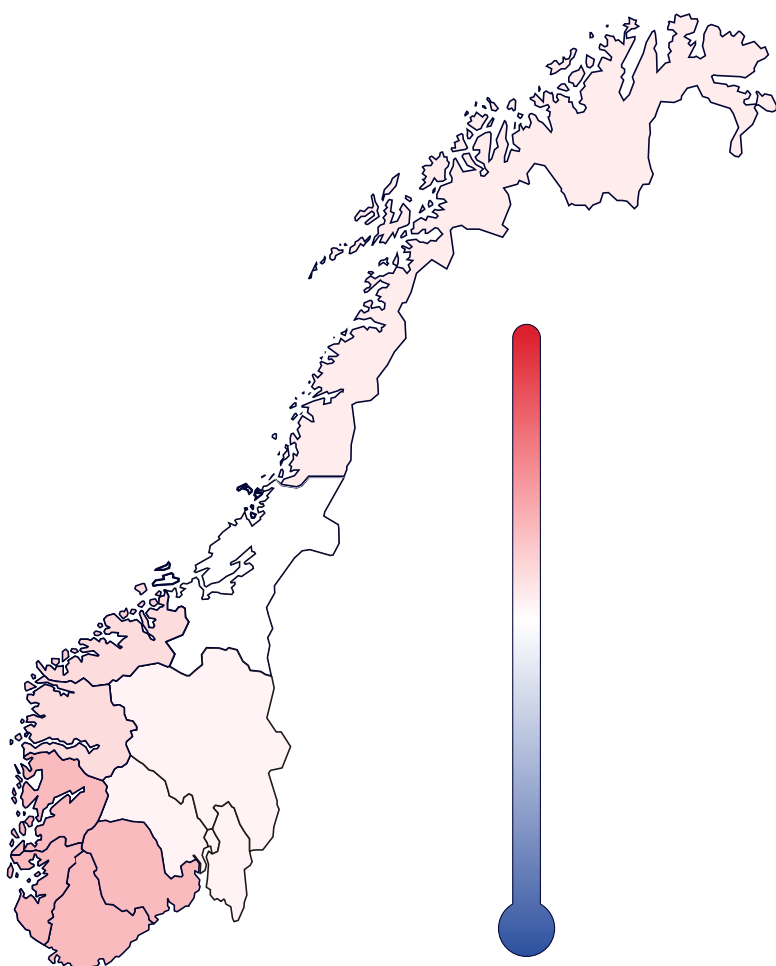

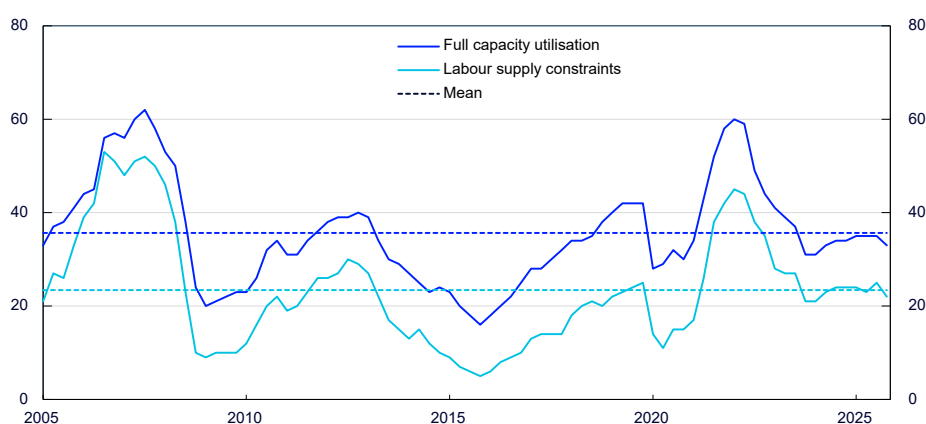


Somewhat lower capacity utilisation

The share of contacts in Norges Bank's Regional Network reporting full capacity utilisation fell somewhat compared with the preceding surveys in 2025. At the same time, fewer contacts are facing recruitment difficulties. Contacts expect output growth to remain elevated in the final months of 2025 but to decline slightly towards spring. On the one hand, they expect higher household purchasing power to strengthen demand for both goods and services. On the other hand, contacts expect low housing construction, weak demand from the local government sector, international trade tensions and completion of oil-related projects to dampen growth. Contacts have revised down their employment plans slightly but still expect growth through 2025 Q4 and 2026 Q1.

Percentage shares

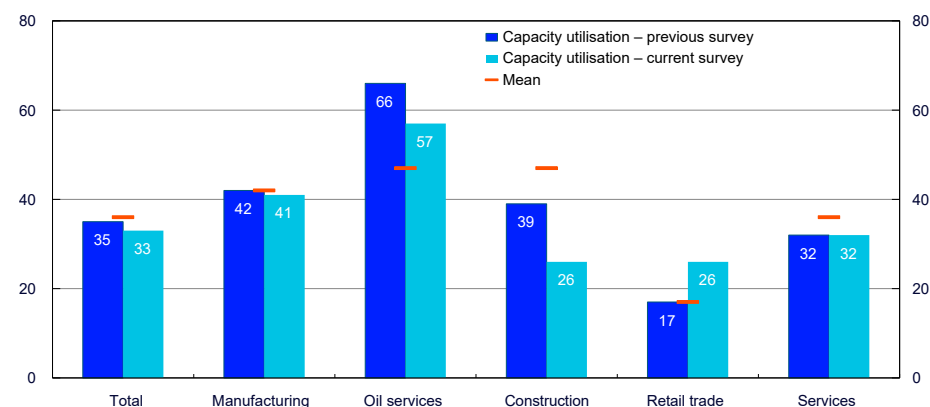


1 Share of contacts that will face some or considerable difficulty increasing output/sales without committing additional resources such as labour or machinery.

Recruitment difficulties have eased slightly

In this survey, 33% of contacts report full capacity utilisation (Charts 1 and 2), which is somewhat lower compared with the preceding surveys in 2025 and somewhat below the historical average for this indicator. Contacts are also asked about their capacity utilisation relative to a normal level. Contacts reporting lower-than-normal capacity utilisation somewhat outnumber those reporting the opposite. In addition, a number of contacts report that recruitment difficulties have eased, and the share reporting recruitment difficulties has fallen to 21%, but this is still close to the historical average for this indicator.

Contacts expect slightly slower growth

On the whole, Norges Bank's Regional Network Contacts expect growth to remain elevated in 2025 Q4 and then fall slightly in 2026 Q1 (Charts 3 and 4). Retail trade contacts have revised up their growth expectations for 2025 Q4. At the same time, prospects in services are little changed, and the other sectors have revised down expectations for Q4. Both oil

Expected growth current quarter and next quarter. Seasonally adjusted. Percent

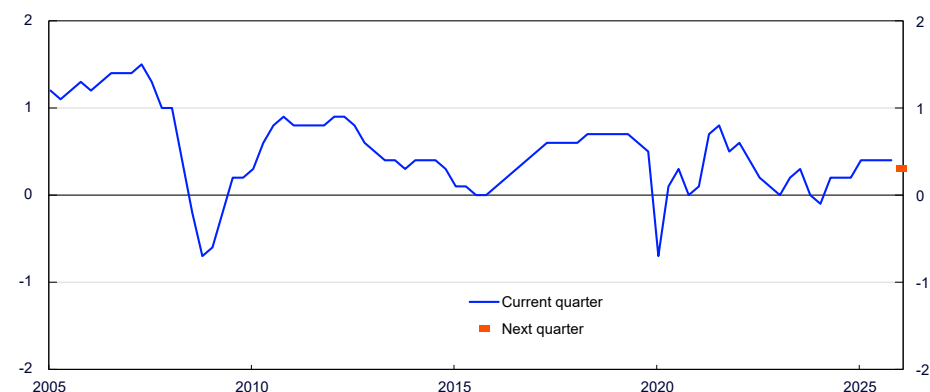
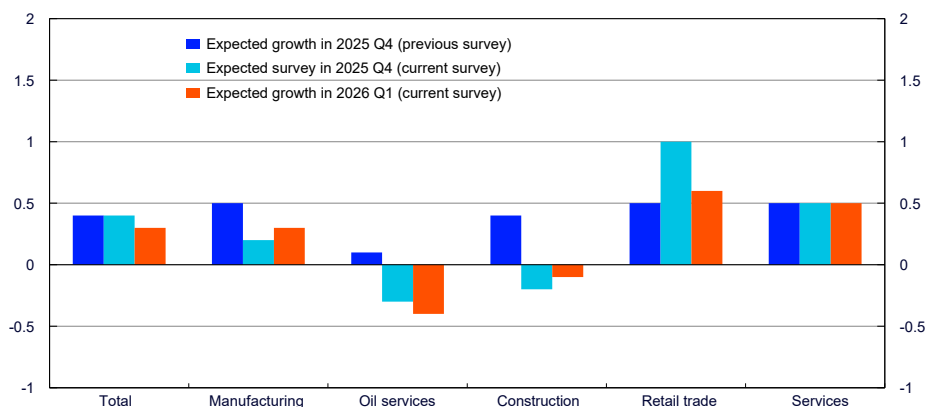


Chart 4 Output growth. All sectors

services and construction contacts now expect lower activity through winter, while the other sectors still expect a rise in activity.

High household demand

Retail contacts expect growth to accelerate from Q3 to Q4 and then decline at the beginning of 2026. Contacts point in particular to the announced changes in VAT for electric vehicles that have resulted in strong sales growth ahead of the New Year. At the same time, growth expectations in retail are broad-based. Contacts envisage an increase in consumer durables sales this winter, and some point to stronger household purchasing power. Some building materials retail contacts report high household demand, while demand from building contractors is weak. Contacts also expect that sales of consumer nondurables will continue to increase through winter.

Among household-oriented services contacts, hardly any envisage declining activity levels through winter, and like retail contacts, some point out that households' spending power has improved. Tourism contacts still expect the strongest growth and report a rise in the number of domestic and foreign guests, and some now also report an increase in the number of non-European guests. Most entertainment, leisure activity and communication services contacts also expect growth through winter.

Commercial services contacts expect growth to remain elevated through winter. As in previous surveys, many contacts cite global uncertainty as a reason for customer caution, particularly contacts in market communication, courses and conferences, information technology and consultancy services. At the same time, low activity in construction is dampening order volumes among recruitment agencies, architects, technical consultants and logistics firms. However, firms report a rise in demand from defence and emergency preparedness, health, aquaculture and energy sectors.

Weakened prospects in construction

In August, construction contacts expected growth to pick up somewhat in Q4. They are more pessimistic in this survey and expect declining activity levels within both construction in general and in construction of new buildings. This decline primarily reflects lower order volumes from the local government sector, and a number of contacts report postponements or cancellations of local government projects. At the same time, large public projects are sustaining activity for some contacts. Construction contacts emphasise that housing construction is very low, and a number of contacts report that new home sales have been weaker this autumn than expected. However, few contacts expect a further decline ahead, and some are planning to increase housing starts. Contacts report that private commercial building construction projects are also at a low level and point to continued high construction and financing costs dampening order intake. However, many contacts report growth in the renovation and maintenance of existing homes and commercial buildings.

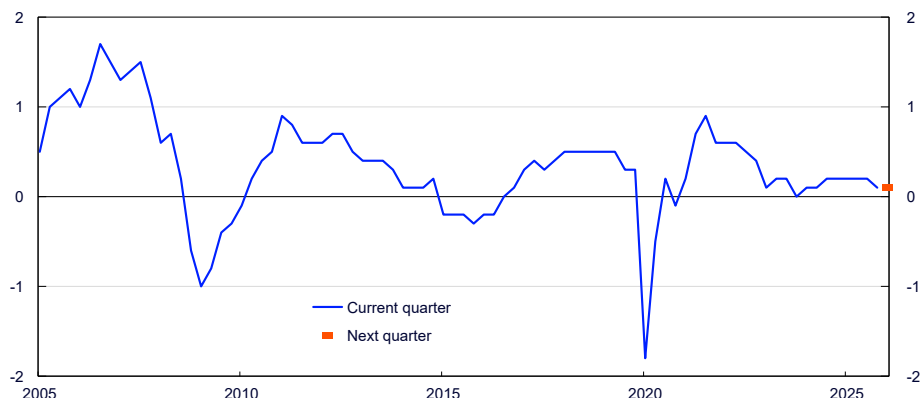
Weaker growth in manufacturing

Contacts in manufacturing have revised down their growth expectations for Q4 but expect a gradual increase in growth through winter. In aquaculture, growth was rapid in 2025 H1. This autumn, salmon louse problems worsened for a number of contacts, and they also expect that this will dampen growth ahead. In addition, low fish stocks result in smaller wild fish quotas. Contacts also point to global trade policy uncertainty, but the number of contacts reporting that tariffs on Norwegian goods are dampening activity remains low. Some contacts, however, report that higher tariffs on goods between China and the US lead to stronger competition from Chinese manufacturers in the European market. Contacts report weak demand from the construction sector, both in Norway and abroad. On the other hand, there is rapid growth in the defence industry. A number of contacts also point to growth related to electrification and energy transition, although some contacts also report failed green manufacturing projects.

Oil services contacts envisage lower order volumes through winter, and expectations for Q4 have been revised down since the preceding survey. In the domestic market, reduced investment, falling demand and the completion of projects in response to the petroleum tax package leads to weaker developments. Lower oil and gas prices are mentioned as one important reason for heightened caution and deferred investment both in Norway and abroad. In the export market, a number of contacts point to stronger competition from Asian market participants and uncertainty about political framework conditions. On the other hand, there is a rise in activity for some export contacts, partly owing to the EU's drive to replace Russian gas.

Slightly weaker employment growth

Overall employment expectations are slightly weaker than in the preceding surveys (Chart 5). Both oil services and construction contacts will reduce staff numbers as a result of expected lower activity levels. In other sectors, contacts plan to increase staff numbers. However, this growth is dampened because a number of contacts have spare capacity, and some are implementing measures to optimise efficiency.

Minor changes in annual wage growth projections

Contacts expect annual wage growth of 4.4% in 2025 and 4.1% in 2026 (Chart 6). The projection for 2025 has been revised down slightly from the preceding survey, while the projection for 2026 has been revised up slightly. Relatively few contacts in this survey point to a tight labour market, and many still expect that inflation will have a substantial impact on wage growth in 2026. Some contacts point out that the wage settlement in manufacturing will provide the norm for wage growth and that employees expect real wage growth in 2026 as well.

Expected annual wage growth. Percent

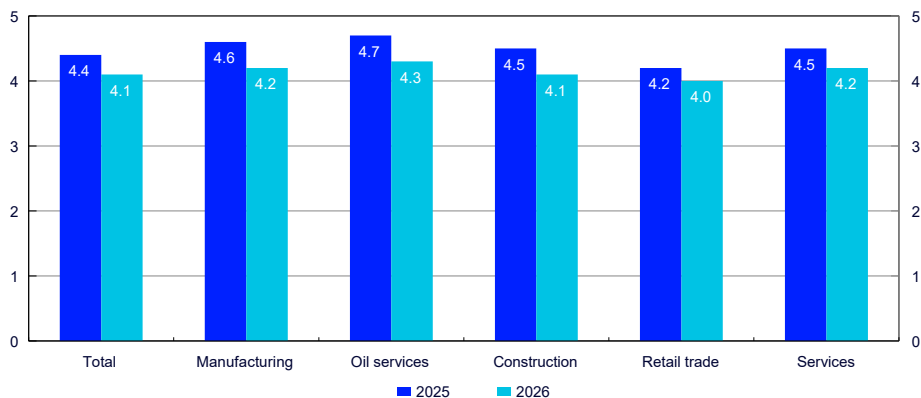
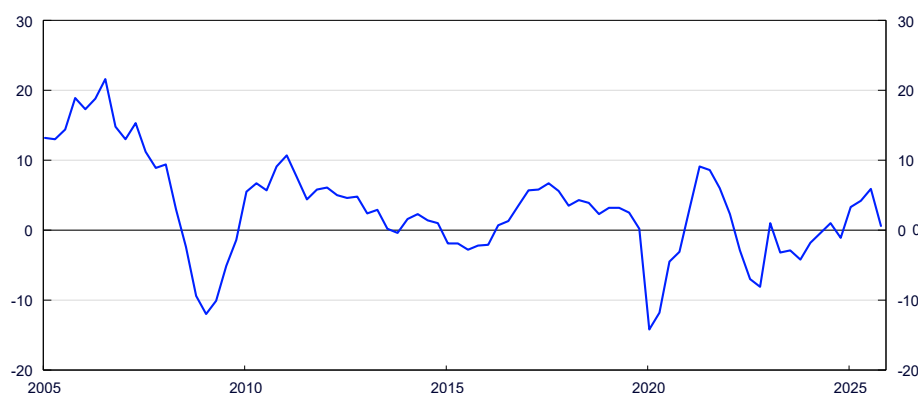


Chart 7 Overall profitability growth

Services boost investment

Contacts expect that investment will be somewhat higher in 2025 than in 2024 and that investment will increase further in 2026. Services contacts in particular contribute to the expected rise in investment in 2026 as they have revised up their investment expectations for both 2025 and 2026. Household-oriented services contacts point in particular to higher investment in tourism business premises. Services contacts that supply other firms, mainly invest in IT solution upgrades and some plan to increase investment in commercial buildings in 2026. Retail contacts have increased investment in 2025 as a result of deferred investment in preceding years and envisage little change in investment in 2026. Manufacturing contacts report increased investment in 2025 and are planning for continued weak investment growth in 2026. However, a number of contacts report that they are now waiting to launch new projects as a result of reduced global demand and slightly lower profitability.

Overall, profitability among contacts is approximately unchanged from 2024 Q4 (Chart 7). Construction contacts report reduced profitability from an already low level as a result of high construction costs and low activity levels. At the same time, cost-cutting measures, such as reducing the number of permanent and contract staff, have dampened the decline. In retail, profitability has increased in pace with higher household demand, while other industries report minor changes to margins.

The economic situation is weakest in regions Central, Inland and East.

Contacts are asked, on a scale from -3 to +3, how they would rate their economic situation in terms of demand, profitability and prospects. A value of zero indicates a normal situation. The regional indicator is an average of the responses in the individual region. In this survey, all regional indicators are positive, with the exception of a neutral indicator for region Central. Nevertheless, indicators are lower than in the preceding survey in a majority of the regions. As in previous surveys, the

economic situation is most favourable for contacts in region South-West, but in this survey, contacts in region South report an equally strong situation. Compared with the preceding survey, contacts in retail trade and household-oriented services in particular contribute to the improvement in region South. On the other hand, the economic situation is weakest in regions Central, Inland and East, where regional indicators are dampened in particular by declining activity levels in construction.

Special topic: Artificial intelligence use among firms

In this survey, contacts were asked about their use and the effects of artificial intelligence (AI) in 2025. The vast majority responded that they use AI and that usage is widespread in all sectors. Usage is more common among large contacts than small, but a majority of the small contacts also respond that they have adopted such tools.

In the survey, contacts were asked to provide examples of what they used AI for:

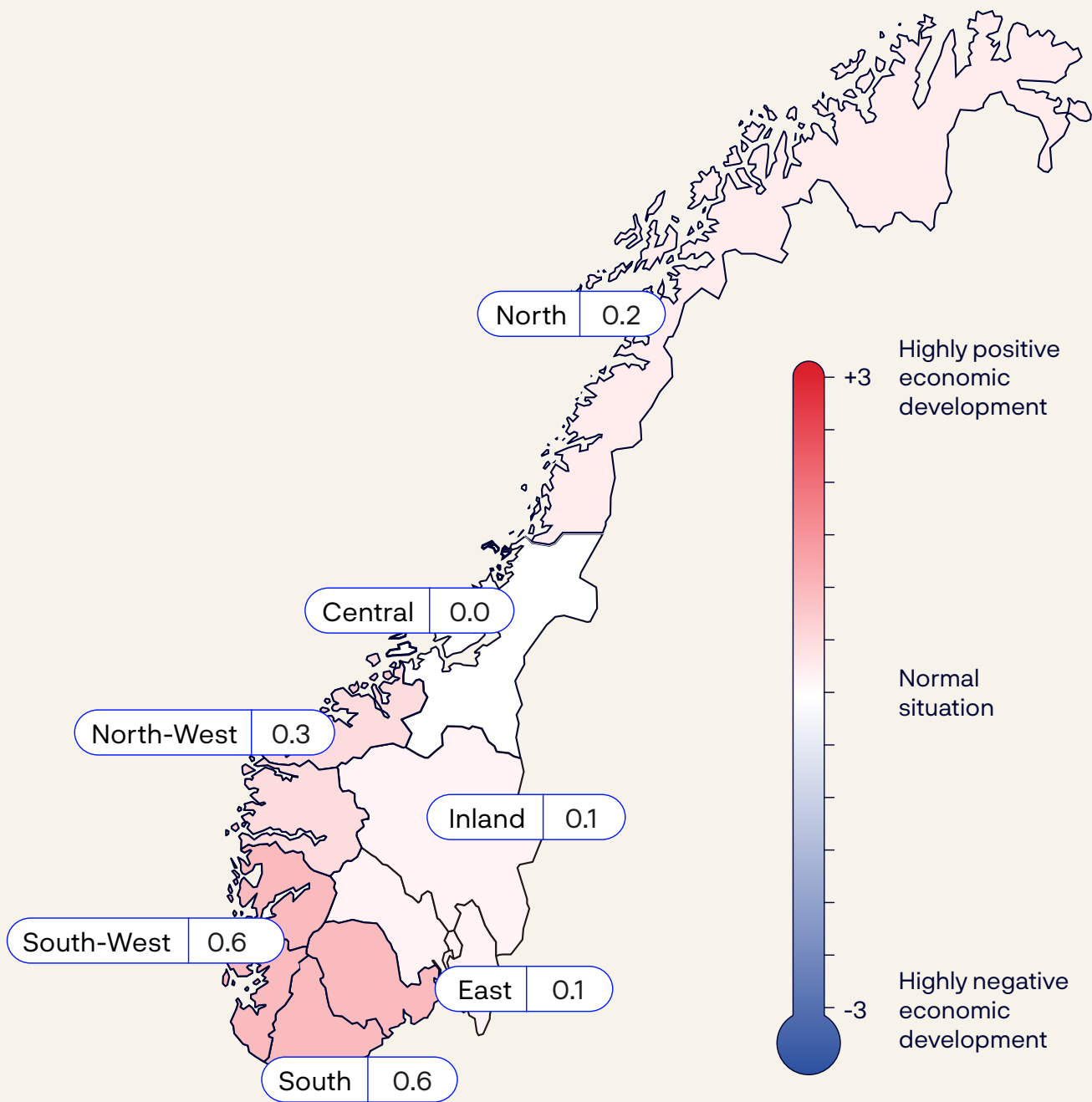
- In *manufacturing*, AI is used, among other things, for the analysis of markets, customers and providers, production planning, logistics and to automate administrative tasks.
- *Oil services contacts* report AI usage for the automation of procurement, the preparation and analysis of tenders, data analysis and the production of management tools to streamline operations.
- *Construction contacts* use AI to prepare tenders and project calculations, for quality control and error reporting and for systematisation and to streamline planning processes.
- *Retail trade contacts* use AI as an aid in the automation of customer services and the production of marketing and website content, and as a forecasting tool for inventory and financial management.
- *Services contacts* have adopted AI to write minutes, analyse market data, translate and systematise documents and to prepare various reports, including audit and sustainability reports.

Many contacts state that AI in particular streamlines administrative and analytical tasks and frees up time. Almost half of contacts responded that their use of AI resulted in a need for new skills. The net effect of using AI in one's own firm appears to be positive for turnover and profitability in 2025, but AI also appears to dampen the need for labour. A number of contacts emphasise that AI tools remain in a development phase and that the effects on profitability and labour are still uncertain.

Contacts were also asked how customers' use of AI affected demand for their products in 2025. Most contacts responded that demand has not been affected. To the extent that AI usage among customers has an effect, it appears mainly to boost demand among contacts. Among the few firms that report that there is a dampening effect on demand from AI, the majority are service contacts.
