




PMI for Norway's trading partners


Manufacturing and services PMI. 25 main trading partners. Export weights. January 2010 – December 2018

Historical average and projections from the IMF. Percent. 2016 – 2017¹⁾





Inflation for selected trading partners


Twelve-month change. Percent. January 2010 – November/December 2018

Policy rates and estimated forward rates¹⁾. Percent. 21 January 2019 (solid line) and MPR 4/18 (broken line)





Three-month money market rates for Norway's trading partners. Percent. 2012 Q1 – 2018 Q4¹⁾







USD/barrel. Daily data. January 2010 – January 2019¹⁾




Import-weighted exchange rate index (I-44)

Monthly and three-month growth. Seasonally adjusted. Percent. February 2016 - March 2019¹⁾




Private consumption for households and non-profit organisations. Three-month growth. Seasonally adjusted. Percent. June 2016 – November 2018


Consumer Confidence Index (CCI) and Kantar TNS Consumer Sentiment Index. Net values. January 2008 – December 2018





House prices


Percent. January 2015 – December 2018

C2. Percent. January 2015 – November 2018¹⁾



Petroleum investment. Annual change. Percent. 2012 – 2017¹⁾





As a percentage of the labour force. Seasonally adjusted. January 2012 – October / December 2018¹⁾





Twelve-month change. Percent. January 2012 – December 2018¹⁾



Twelve-month change. Percent. January 2012 – December 2018¹⁾



Twelve-month change. Percent. January 2002 - December 2018


