There will be a special session on "Issues and Challenges in Structural Macroeconomics" with invited speaker Frank Schorfheide, University of Pennsylvania

We would welcome submissions for these sessions. Submissions for the contributed sessions should be sent to esobe@norges-bank.no by the end of Sunday 7th April 2013.

The registration fee is 2000 NOK. ISBA/EFaB members can apply for a reduced fee of 1400 NOK. The fees include lunch on each day of the workshop, one dinner and coffee breaks but do not include the hotel. Researchers who received their Ph.D. after October 2008 or expect to graduate by November 2015, may register as "junior scientist" (a detailed CV has to be submitted during registration). Junior scientists may apply for a travel award (an option offered during registration). Papers submitted by junior scientists will be eligible for the Special Session of Junior Scientist Presentations.
