


GDP for trading partners, including and excluding China


Seasonally adjusted volume index. 2008 Q1 = 100. 2008 Q1 - 2015 Q1

Twelve-month change. Percent. January 2010 – May 2015¹⁾



Yields on 10-year government bonds





1 January 2014 – 15 June 2015



USD per barrel. January 2010 - December 2018




Growth in output past three months and expected growth next six months. Annualised. Percent. January 2008 – November 2015

Expected output growth next six months. Annualised. Percent



Volume. Annual change. Percent. 2011 – 2018¹⁾








House prices




Unemployment rate

Seasonally adjusted. Percent. January 2008 – May 2015




Immigration

Net migration by country of origin. In thousands of persons. 2003 – 2018¹⁾




Employed with a foreign background

Annual growth. Percent. 2008 – 2015¹⁾






Twelve-month change. Percent. January 2011 – June 2015¹⁾








Factors behind changes in the interest rate forecast since MPR 1/15
