




# PMI for Norway's trading partners


Manufacturing and services PMI. Twenty-five main trading partners. Export weights. January 2010 – September 2019





### Inflation for selected trading partners


Twelve-month change. Percent. January 2010 – December 2019





# Crude oil spot and futures prices


USD/barrel. January 2013 - December 2022

Policy rate and estimated forward rates<sup>1)</sup>. Percent. 22 January 2020 (solid line) and MPR 3/19 (broken line)



Three-month money market rates for Norway's trading partners. Percent. 2012 Q1 – 2022 Q4







Percentage points. 1 January 2015 – 31 December 2022<sup>1)</sup>







Nominal, floating interest rate. February 2015 – November/January 2019<sup>1)</sup>





# Import-weighted exchange rate index (I-44)



# **NOK** against other currencies


Percentage movement in the exchange rate. 13 September – 20 December 2019



Business tendency survey. Composite indicator. Net values. PMI. Diffusion index. Seasonally adjusted. February 2004 – December 2019






Consumer Confidence Index (CCI) and Kantar TNS Consumer Sentiment Index. Net values. January 2008 – December 2018

Annual change. Percent. 2010 – 2020<sup>1)</sup>



Share of labour force. Seasonally adjusted. January 2012 – March 2020<sup>1)</sup>



Monthly and twelve-month change. Percent. January 2015 – December 2019





#### Twelve-month change. Percent. January 2012 – March 2020<sup>1)</sup>



Twelve-month change. Percent. January 2012 – March 2020<sup>1)</sup>








#### **CPI** and indicators of underlying inflation

Twelve-month change. Percent. January 2002 – December 2019




