


#### Monetary Policy Report 4/20, overall picture

Change in the number of registered infected per 100 000 population. Seven-day moving average. 1 January 2020 – 19 January<sup>1)</sup> 2021








# **GDP** forecast for trading partners<sup>1)</sup>

Level. Index. 2019 = 100. 2019 - 2023



### **PMI** for trading partners


Diffusion index. January 2018 - December 2020





# **Crude oil spot and futures prices**


USD/barrel. January 2010 - December 2024



# Money market rates for trading partners


Three-month money market rates for Norway's trading partners. Percent. 2012 Q1 – 2022 Q4





# Long-term sovereign yields


Ten-year government bonds. Percent. 1 January 2020 – 19 January 2021







Percentage points. 1 January 2015 – 31 December 2022<sup>1)</sup>





Nominal, floating interest rate. July 2018 – January 2021<sup>1)</sup>



October 2019 - March 20211)





#### C2. Twelve-month change. Percent. January 2015 – March 2021<sup>1)</sup>



Monthly growth. Seasonally adjusted. Percent. January 2020 – March 2021<sup>1)</sup>





Seasonally adjusted volume index<sup>1)</sup>. January 2015 – November 2020



1) BankAxept includes only purchases at physical points of sale in Norway and some points of sale across the Swedish border.



Twelve-month change. Percent. January 2015 – March 2021<sup>1)</sup>



Share of labour force. Percent. Seasonally adjusted. January 2018 – March 2021<sup>1)</sup>





Share of the labour force. Unadjusted. Week 41 2020 - Week 12 2021<sup>1)</sup>




# Fully and partly unemployed

# LFS employment and hours worked


In thousands. Population aged 15-74. Seasonally adjusted. January 2014 – October 2020




### **CPI** and indicators of underlying inflation



Twelve-month change. Percent. January 2014 – March 2021<sup>1)</sup>





