


Monetary Policy Report 1/21, overall picture

Change in the number of infected per day


Change in the number of registered infected per 100 000 population. Seven-day moving average. 2 March 2020 – 4 May 2021



Vaccination coverage abroad


Share vaccinated with first dose.

Level. Index. 2019 = 100. 2019 – 2024








Twelve-month change. Percent. January 2010 – March 2021


Crude oil spot and futures prices




Money market rates for trading partners

Three-month money market rates for Norway's trading partners. Percent. 2015 Q1 – 2024 Q4




Long-term sovereign yields

Ten-year government bonds. Percent. 1 January 2020 – 4 May 2021




Global equity markets

Index. 1 January 2020 = 100. 1 January – 4 May 2021




Three-month money market premium

Banks' residential mortgage rates





Import-weighted exchange rate index (I-44) January 2020 – June 2021¹⁾




Credit growth

C2. Twelve-month change. Percent. January 2015 – June 2021¹⁾




GDP mainland Norway

Monthly and three-month growth. Seasonally adjusted. Percent. January 2020 – June 2021¹⁾




Expected output growth next quarter

Goods consumption


Seasonally adjusted volume index. January 2015 – March 2021



Value of card transactions via BankAxept relative to 2019.^{1) 2)} Percent. January 2020 – April 2021




Consumer confidence (CCI)


Twelve-month change. Percent. January 2015 – June 2021¹⁾


Building permits issued for housing starts

Share of labour force. Percent. Seasonally adjusted.



Registered unemployment – ordinary and furloughs



Twelve-month change. Percent. January 2015 – June 2021¹⁾


